When Annie Dove Morrison started school, the teacher asked each of the children their names. Some of the names were found to be funny by some of the other children. Fearing that Annie Dove would draw laughter, when it came to her turn Annie made up the name Annie Stevens Morrison. None of the family knew where she came up with "Stevens", but she used it as her middle name from that time on. Even her diploma from Smith College says Annie Stevens Morrison. She also preferred "Ann" to "Annie", thus when I was named after her, she asked that I be named Ann
