



SIMEON HALL SAWYER

was the youngest of the four children of Edward M. and Frances V. (Hall) Sawyer. As an adult, he lived for a time in Pittsfield, ME and worked in a bank there. In his early 30's, he died of tuberculosis. He had been engaged before his death, but when he became ill, the girl to whom he was engaged didn't go to see him. He broke the engagement and reclaimed the diamond ring that he had given to her, saying that he did not want to die being engaged to her. He is buried next to his mother and father in the cemetery in Jonesport.

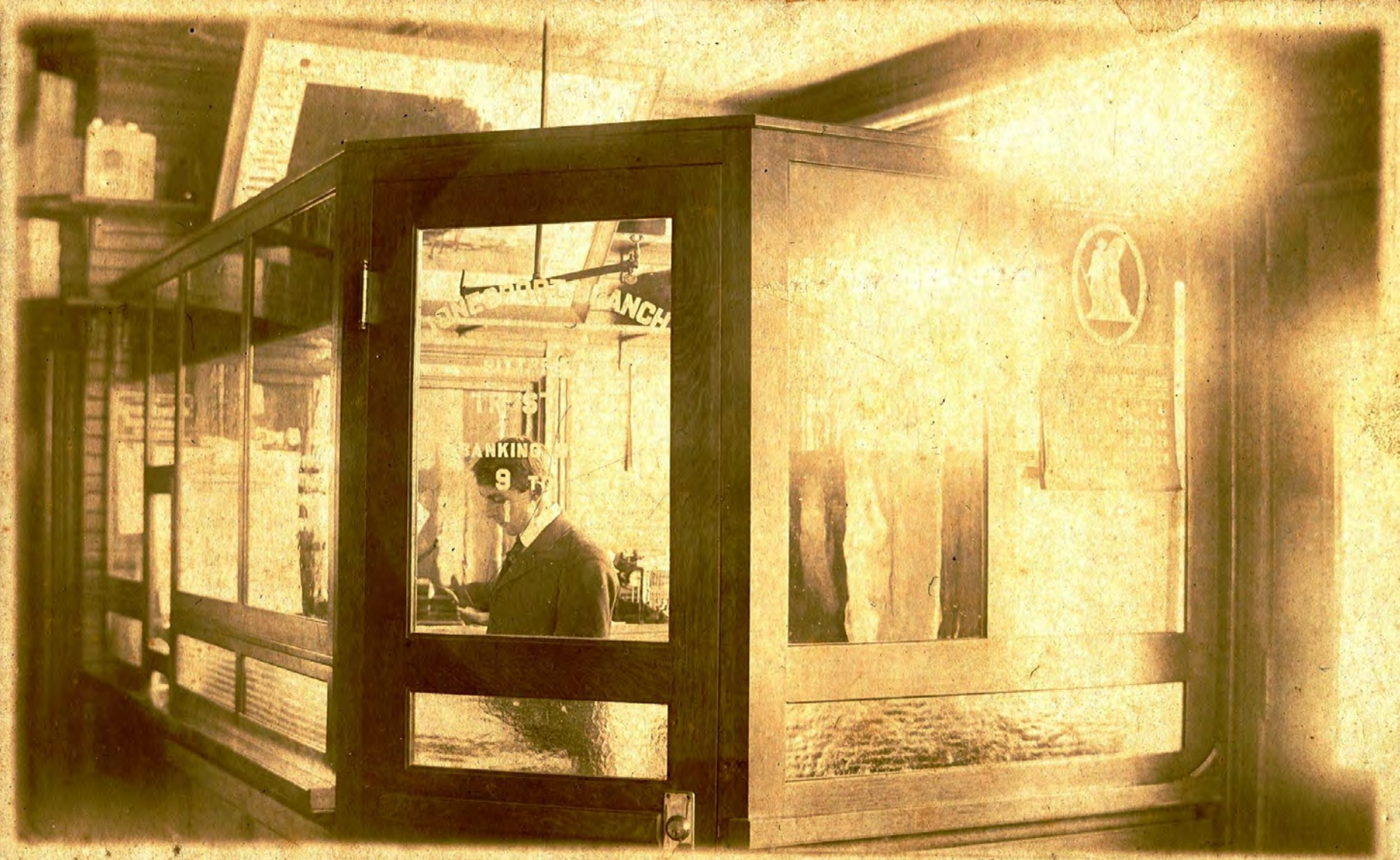
