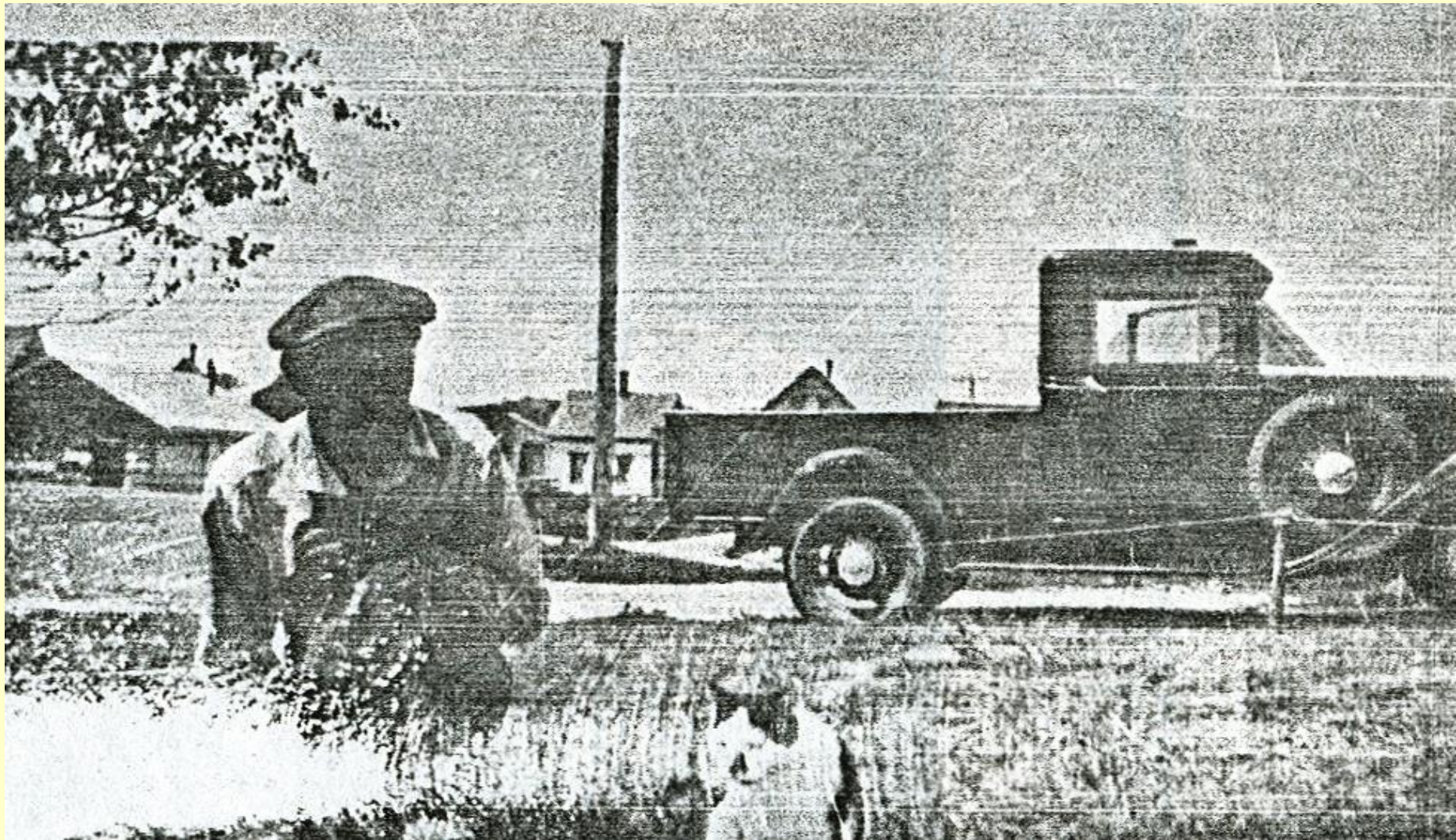

**West Jonesport
Lobsterman Lost**

West Jonesport, Feb. 1—(AP)—

This fishing port mourned today as lost at sea William Wallace, 48, whose lobster boat was found adrift nearly 10 miles from his trap-line.

Apparently, colleagues, told the Coast Guard, Wallace fell overboard en route to his traps Saturday and his power boat went on until its gasoline ran out.

A small sail had kept the craft approximately on its course. Raymond Smith, another lobster fisherman, found the empty boat and turned it over to the Coast Guard.

Wallace left a widow, Mrs. Ida Huntley Wallace.
